

Gloucestershire cheese wins top award

A GLOUCESTERSHIRE cheese has won a prestigious award.

Godsell's Church Farm won gold for its Single Gloucester in the British Cheese Awards.

Liz Godsell, who makes the cheese with her husband Bryan at the farm in Leonards Stanley, said they were over the moon.

She said: "We are delighted that we won gold for our Single Gloucester. We entered back in July and but we didn't find out until last Friday when the winners were announced at the cheese festival in Cardiff.

"But we are absolutely thrilled with the result."

Liz and Bryan have been making the exclusive cheese at the farm for about five years using milk from their own cows and other farms in the area.

"Single Gloucester is very unique to Gloucester and it has a protected designated origin, like Champagne, so can only be made in Gloucestershire.

"It is quite unique and we are one of only four cheesemakers that make it," Liz added.
